DAY BEFORE THE PROCEDURE:

1. ABSOLUTELY NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT.

DAY OF THE PROCEDURE:

- DO NOT TAKE INSULIN OR DIABETES MEDICATIONS. Please <u>take</u> blood pressure, thyroid, and seizure medications with a small sip of water! <u>Bring all</u> <u>meds to office</u>.
- 2. **NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK,** except small sip of water with medications listed above!
- 3. WE WILL NOT START YOUR PROCEDURE UNLESS A RESPONSIBLE DRIVER IS PRESENT! THEY MUST REMAIN THE ENTIRE PROCEDURE should any questions or emergencies arise. YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO DRIVE AT ALL ON THE DAY OF PROCEDURE!

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. HOLD Aspirin, Coumadin, Warfarin, Plavix, Clopidogrel, and any other blood thinners for (4) days prior to procedure unless otherwise directed.
- If you are diabetic, ONLY TAKE HALF DOSE OF INSULIN AT BEDTIME because you will not be able to eat breakfast. DO NOT TAKE ANY INSULIN OR ORAL DIABETIC MEDS the morning of your procedure.
- 3. LEAVE JEWELRY AND OTHER VALUABLES AT HOME.
- 4. You may wear your dentures/ partials, but they **must be removed prior to your procedure.**
